**AN ACT REQUIRING SCHOOL BUS SEATS TO BE NO MORE THAN
TWENTY-FOUR INCHES IN HEIGHT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,
2 or rule or regulation of the registrar of motor vehicles, school
3 bus seatbacks shall not be less than twenty-two inches in
4 height and no more than twenty-four inches in height when
5 measured from the top of the undepressed cushion and that
6 these seats shall be of the type generally known as "fully
7 padded".
