

SENATE No. 1145

By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1145) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation concerning the powers of railroad, railway, railway express or steamboat police officers. Public Safety.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE POWERS OF RAILROAD, RAILWAY, RAILWAY EXPRESS OR STEAMBOAT POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 93 of chapter 159 of the Massachusetts General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence thereof
3 and inserting the following:

4 In addition to the aforementioned powers, said railroad,
5 railway, railway express or steamboat police officers shall
6 possess and exercise such other powers to arrest without a
7 warrant on or off the premises, or on the cars, vehicles, ves-
8 sels or boats of such corporation or company and at the
9 wharves and landing places owned or used by such carrier by
10 water, as are conferred on police officers of the cities and towns
11 of the Commonwealth.
