AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO PICK UP THE TOTAL COST OF OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE EXTENSION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY BLUE LINE, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
