

**SENATE . . . . . No. 1654**

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By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1654) of Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to revise the basis for apportionment of certain costs of construction of the sewerage system of the Metropolitan District Commission. Urban Affairs.

AN ACT REVISING THE BASIS FOR APPORTIONMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 5B, the following section:—  
3 *Section 5C.* The cost of construction, reconstruction, reha-  
4 bilitation and repair of such works and facilities, including, but  
5 not limited to, pumping station, relief, trunk and other sewers,  
6 within the metropolitan sewerage district and begun on or  
7 after the first day of January, 1971, and deemed by the com-  
8 mission, with the concurrence of the water resources commis-  
9 sion, to be water quality improvement projects for the purpose  
10 of improving the quality of the waters of Massachusetts Bay,  
11 or any part thereof, shall be paid for by the cities and towns  
12 belonging in whole or in part to the metropolitan sewerage  
13 district. Each such city and town shall annually pay money to  
14 the commonwealth to meet interest and principal payments for  
15 each fiscal year on the debt for such construction, reconstruc-  
16 tion, rehabilitation and repair in proportion to the ratios estab-  
17 lished by the commission pursuant to sections 5 and 5A for the  
18 fiscal year wherein such construction, reconstruction, rehabili-  
19 tation and repair is first authorized.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE COMMISSION ON THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPOSITION, ORGANIZATION, AND FUNCTIONS OF SAID COMMISSION.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, July 13, 1956.
