SENATE, January 6, 1975.

1 *Ordered*, That the joint special committee authorized to  
2 make an investigation and study relative to medical benefits  
3 (under the provisions of House Order, No. 5049 of 1971), is  
4 hereby revived and continued until the last Wednesday of De-  
5 cember in 1976; provided, however, that the special committee  
6 hereby continued which was created prior to the nineteen hun-  
7 dred and seventy-three legislative session shall file a status  
8 report by the last Wednesday in December of nineteen hun-  
9 dred and seventy-five. Such report shall include information  
10 as to the activities of such committee. Such report shall be  
11 filed with the clerk of the house of representatives, and shall  
12 be available for public inspection.

COMMISSIONERS OF THE LAND OFFICE

1. That the joint special committee authorized to  
 2. make an investigation and report relative to medical benefits  
 3. under the provisions of House Order No. 200 of 1872, is  
 4. hereby notified and directed with the said committee of 187-  
 5. 2 to make a report in 1873; provided, however, that the special com-  
 6. mittee authorized which was created prior to the creation of this  
 7. committee may continue to exercise its powers in all other in-  
 8. stances not covered by the provisions of the said order. It shall be  
 9. the duty of the said committee to report on the said subject  
 10. to the committee of 1872, and the report shall be laid on the table  
 11. of the Senate, and the committee of 1872 shall be authorized to  
 12. be available for public inspection.
