### RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO ENACT A NATIONAL HEALTH CARE EXPANSION AND IMPROVE- MENT ACT.

*Whereas*, The per capita cost of medical services is higher in the United States than in other developed nations; and

*Whereas*, The health delivery system of the United States is significantly behind that of other developed nations in important categories; now, therefore, be it

*Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts hereby respectfully urges the Congress of the United States to enact a national health insurance program that will provide for expanded and improved benefits for the health care of all our citizens.
