AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN LAND IN THE CITY OF WESTFIELD FOR PARK PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of environmental management
2 is hereby authorized to acquire by eminent domain or by pur-
3 chase or otherwise certain land with buildings thereon in the
4 city of Westfield and to maintain and develop said land as a
5 state park. Said land is bounded and described as follows:

6 Beginning at a point in the northerly line of the state high-
7 way known as route 202 at the intersection of said line with
8 the westerly line of Old County Road (City of Westfield),
9 Thence northeasterly along the westerly line of Old County
10 Road to its intersection with the southerly line of Italian Club
11 Road,

12 Thence along the southerly line of Italian Club Road to its
13 intersection with the westerly line of Peach Street,

14 Thence northerly along the westerly side of Peach Street to
15 its intersection with northerly property line of land now or
16 formerly owned by Sigefroid Paquette, a distance of approx-
17 imately 40 feet,

18 Thence westerly along the northerly property line of land
19 now or formerly owned by Sigefroid Paquette to the Great
20 Pond line of Pequot Pond,

21 Thence southerly and then westerly and by various courses
22 generally tending in a westerly direction along said Great
23 Pond line to a point northerly of a culvert between Long Pond
24 and Pequot Pond, a distance of approximately 4,600 feet,

25 Thence by a line curving generally to the left running par-
26 allel to and fifty feet distant from the high water mark of Long
27 Pond to the northerly line of state highway route 202 afore-
28 said.

29 Thence along said northerly line of the state highway to the
30 point of beginning, a distance of approximately 4,100 feet.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter six hundred and five of the acts of nine-
2 teen hundred and sixty-six is hereby repealed.
