*LEGISLATIVE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE  
OFFICE FOR CHILDREN*

1. AN ACT TO AMEND THE COMPOSITION OF THE STATE-WIDE ADVISORY COUNCIL TO THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.
2. AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE ON CRIMINAL JUSTICE.
3. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PARTICIPATION OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN ON THE RATE SETTING ADVISORY BOARD.
4. AN ACT RAISING THE AGE OF CHILDREN IN PROGRAMS LICENSED BY THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.
5. AN ACT RAISING THE AGE OF CHILDREN COVERED BY THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.
6. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE REGULATION OF FAMILY FOSTER CARE NOT SUPERVISED AND APPROVED BY A LICENSED PLACEMENT AGENCY.
