AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENTS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 section 87 of chapter 835 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the fifth paragraph and inserting in place
4 thereof the following paragraph:—

5 A provisional appointment to fill a permanent or temporary
6 position shall be terminated by the administrator within thirty
7 days after the establishment of an eligible list for such position,
8 however, if the position is in the Department of Mental Health
9 and said position is filled by a person invloved in the direct care of
10 mentally ill or mentally retarded persons such provisional
11 appointment may be extended by the administrator for a period
12 not to exceed sixty days if the commissioner of Mental Health
13 certifies to the administrator that such extension is required for
14 the best interests of the mentally ill or mentally retarded person.
