AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE INSPECTION OF ELEVATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 62 of chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:
- 3 "Each city or town shall conduct their inspections and shall file
- 4 annually a notice with the city or town clerk, if any maintenance
- 5 or testing has been performed in the preceding year, and the name
- 6 and address of the maintenance company".
