Accompanying the sixteenth recommendation of the Department of Public Works (House, No. 163). Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SAFETY DEVICES AT ROADSIDE DEVELOPMENT LOCATIONS ADJACENT TO STATE HIGHWAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 81, Section 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting between the last sentence and the next to the last
3 sentence the following:

4 Any person who builds or expands his business or residential
5 facility adjacent to a state highway so as to generate a substantial
6 increase in traffic, causing the department in accordance with
7 accepted and Prevailing Traffic Standards to install traffic
8 signals, pavement markings, channelization or traffic control
9 devices, shall be assessed seventy-five percent of the cost thereof.
