

Chap. 35. AN ACT DESIGNATING UNITED STATES HIGHWAY ROUTE 20 FROM THE WESTFIELD-RUSSELL TOWN LINE TO THE LEE-BCKET TOWN LINE AS THE 104TH UNITED STATES INFANTRY VETERANS HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

That portion of United States highway route 20 from the Westfield-Russell town line to the Lee-Becket town line shall be designated and known as the 104th United States Infantry Veterans highway. The department of public works shall erect a suitable marker bearing such designation in compliance with the standards of said department and as authorized by the federal highway administration.

Chap. 36. AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE RECLAMATION BOARD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 252 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 1, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 1. If it is necessary or useful (1) to drain or flow a meadow, swamp, marsh, beach or other low land held by two or more proprietors, or (2) to remove obstructions in rivers or streams leading thereto or therefrom, or (3) to eradicate mosquitoes in any area infested thereby, including, in respect to each such purpose, purposes incidental thereto, such improvements may be made as provided in this chapter.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—One employee of the department of ~~public health designated by it, one employee of the department of agriculture designated by it~~ and a third member designated by the heads of said departments acting jointly and with the approval of the governor shall constitute the state reclamation board, in this chapter called the board.

SECTION 3. Section 4 of said chapter 252, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—In carrying out the provisions of this chapter, the board may employ necessary engineers, assistants or other agents, who may enter on land which the board desires to survey or examine.

Chap. 37. AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY MAY BORROW FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW JAIL, HOUSE OF CORRECTION AND SHERIFF'S QUARTERS FOR SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 74 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 7, the words "eight million" and inserting in place thereof the words:—eight million five hundred thousand.
