The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOMEWORK PERFORMED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS REHABILITATION COMMISSION.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to exclude homework performed
3 under the supervision of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation
4 Commission from General Laws, Chapter 149, sections 143 to
5 147G inclusive, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency
6 law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
7 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 147H of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by Section 12 of chapter 535 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: - The provisions of sections one
5 hundred and forty-three to one hundred and forty-seven G,
6 inclusive, shall not apply to organizations incorporated in the
7 commonwealth for educational or philanthropic purposes, or to
8 homework performed under the supervision of the Massachusetts
9 commission for the blind or the Massachusetts rehabilitation
10 commission.
