RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING JUVENILE DETENTION CENTERS FOR THE COMMITMENT AND REHABILITATION OF JUVENILE OFFENDERS AND ANY OTHER RELATED MATTERS THERETO.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two  
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of  
3 representatives, and four persons to be appointed by the  
4 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an  
5 investigation and study of the feasibility of establishing juvenile  
6 detention centers for the commitment and rehabilitation of  
7 juvenile offenders and any other related matters thereto.
