RESOLVE TO STUDY NURSING EDUCATION IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate and five members of the house of
3 representatives, the chancellor of the board of higher education,
4 and five persons to be appointed by the governor, one of whom
5 shall be a member of the nursing profession and one of whom
6 shall be an administrator of a nursing school, is hereby
7 established to investigate and study nursing education in the
8 commonwealth for the purpose of determining if programs
9 should be consolidated or joint programs should be established
10 between the public institutions of higher education and the public
11 and private hospitals in the commonwealth. The commission
12 shall report its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
13 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said
14 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
15 the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday in
16 December nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
