AN ACT REQUIRING THE CITIES OF CHELSEA AND REVERE AND THE TOWN OF WINTHROP TO PAY THEIR PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE EXPENSES OF SUFFOLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Annually before July first, the director of
2 accounts provided for by section one of chapter fourteen of the
3 General Laws shall determine the amount expended by the city of
4 Boston for county purposes in the then-current fiscal year, shall
5 allocate this amount among the cities of Boston, Chelsea and
6 Revere and the town of Winthrop in proportion to their
7 populations as determined by the latest census, state or national,
8 next prior to such allocation, and shall certify to the treasurers of
9 said cities and towns such determination and allocation. On or
10 before November twentieth in each year, there shall be paid to the
11 city of Boston by the cities of Chelsea and Revere and the town of
12 Winthrop the amount of such expenditures respectively allocated
13 to them in such year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first,
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-seven for the fiscal period, July 1,
3 1976 through June 30, 1977.
