

HOUSE No. 661

By Mr. Cusack of Arlington, petition of John F. Cusack that school construction grants to cities and towns and regional school districts be equal. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THE SAME PERCENTAGE SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANTS TO CITIES AND TOWNS AND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948 is
2 hereby amended by striking out clauses (a) and (b), as inserted by
3 section 18 of chapter 492 of the acts of 1974, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following clause:—

5 (a) The total construction grant for any approved school
6 project in any city or town or regional school district shall be
7 sixty-five percent of the product of the final approved cost of the
8 project multiplied by a percentage, which shall be the proportion,
9 to the nearest tenth of one per cent, which the most recent
10 equalized valuation per school attending child for the entire
11 commonwealth bears to the most recent equalized valuation per
12 school attending child of the city or town or of the towns
13 comprising such district; provided, however, that no grant shall
14 be approved for any amount less than sixty-five percent nor more
15 than seventy-five percent of such approved cost.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to school construction
2 projects approved after July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-
3 six.
