The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF PENSIONS AND RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN FORMER PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 982 of the acts of 1971 is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section: —

4 *Section 1.* The annual amount of every pension, retirement
5 allowance or annuity payable to any former employee of the
6 commonwealth or to any school teacher who was employed by
7 the commonwealth or by any county, city, town or district,
8 who at the time of retirement had attained age sixty and had
9 completed at least twenty years of service and who has been
10 retired for a period of at least twenty years prior to the
11 effective date of this act, shall, if the annual amount of such
12 pension, retirement allowance or annuity, together with any
13 increase, but excluding cost of living increase, is less than three
14 thousand dollars, be increased to three thousand dollars.
