AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN MEALS FROM AN EXCISE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2A of Chapter 64B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out paragraph (e), inserted by Chapter 684  
3 of the Acts of 1975 and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 paragraph:—

5 (e) Meals furnished to students only in a cafeteria, dormitory,  
6 fraternity, or sorority maintained in a private, public, or  
7 parochial school, college or university.
