AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING MEALS EXEMPT FROM AN EXCISE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2A of Chapter 64B of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after paragraph (f), inserted by Chapter 684
- 3 of the Acts of 1975, the following new paragraph: —
- 4 (g) Meals furnished to teachers and instructors required to be
- 5 in attendance in school cafeterias wherein meals are exempt
- 6 under paragraph (e) above.
