AN ACT REPEALING THE JUSTICES, CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT COURTS TO ACCRUE VACATION DAYS NOT IN EXCESS OF SIXTY DAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 587 of the Acts of 1975 is hereby repealed.
