### AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEAL ALLOWANCES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, the Personnel Administrators of the Bureau of  
3 Personnel Administration is hereby authorized and directed to  
4 reimbursement employees of the Commonwealth for actual meals  
5 expenses incurred, including tips, not to exceed the following: —

6 Breakfast	\$2.00
7 Lunch (mid-day meal)	\$3.00
8 Supper (evening meal)	\$5.00
9 Midnight Meal	\$2.00
