AN ACT ORDERING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS INVOLVED IN SCHOOL DESEGREGATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Commonwealth will reimburse cities and towns for
- 2 expenditures above the per pupil cost incurred as a result of a
- 3 court order or a state or federal law, resulting in implementation
- 4 of desegregation in the public elementary and secondary schools
- 5 within the Commonwealth.
