AN ACT ALLOWING PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR RELIGIOUS PROPERTIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That in Clause Eleventh, Section Five of Chapter fifty-nine of  
2 the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the  
3 following Words be deleted: "to an amount not exceeding twenty  
4 thousand dollars for"
