## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF HORSE AND DOG RACING MEETINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 128A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 The fee for the license provided for in section three shall be  
5 uniform throughout the commonwealth and shall not exceed two  
6 hundred dollars for each day of any horse or dog racing meeting  
7 provided, that the reduced fee, applicable to a license to any  
8 person holding or conducting a horse or dog racing meeting in  
9 connection with a state or county fair, or any exhibition for the  
10 encouragement or extension of agriculture, shall not exceed one  
11 hundred dollars for each day of such horse or dog racing meeting.
