RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY RELATIVE TO THE AWARDING OF PRIZES AND ADMISSION POLICIES BY THE STOCK CAR RACING INDUSTRY AND ANY OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public safety is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the awarding of prizes and admission policies by the
4 stock car racing industry and any other related matters. Said
5 department shall report to the general court the results of its
6 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
9 the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
