**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT MODIFYING THE CREDIT LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH  
PERTAINING TO THE PURCHASE AND SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS  
FOR RESALE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Section 25 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the third and fourth paragraphs, as  
3 appearing in section 25 of Chapter 574 of the Acts of 1968 and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following two paragraphs:—

5 The licensee under this chapter who places the retail licensee on  
6 the delinquent list shall be prohibited from selling or delivering,  
7 directly or indirectly, alcoholic beverages to said licensee, except  
8 for payment in cash on or before delivery and said licensee who is  
9 posted on the delinquent list shall not purchase or accept delivery  
10 of said alcoholic beverages except for payment in cash on or  
11 before delivery.

12 The licensee shall be prohibited from selling or delivering any  
13 alcoholic beverages to the retail licensee whom it placed on the  
14 delinquent list under this chapter whose name has appeared on  
15 the delinquent list on two hundred and ten or more consecutive  
16 days, the licensee whose name has appeared on the delinquent list  
17 on two hundred and ten or more consecutive days shall not  
18 purchase or accept delivery of any alcoholic beverages from said  
19 licensee. Whenever the license of the licensee whose name appears  
20 on the delinquent list is transferred, the name of the transferee  
21 shall appear in the place and stead of the transferor, as of the date  
22 of license transfer, in the same manner as if no transfer had  
23 occurred.
