AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING EXPENDITURES OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 29 of chapter 35 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 13 of chapter 849 of the acts of 1969, is
- hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:—
 No appropriation shall be made for any item in the county
- No appropriation shall be made for any item in the county budget which is in excess of the proposed amount for that item
