AN ACT TO MAINTAIN MEDICAL AND HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THOSE INSURED PERSONS WHO LOSE THEIR EMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Amend Chapter 175, by adding a new section, section 110E as
2 follows: —

3 Every policy of insurance issued after January 2, 1976 under
4 the provisions of section 110 shall contain a provision that, in the
5 event that the insured person's employment is terminated by the
6 employer under such circumstances so as to provide unemploy-
7 ment benefits for the insured person under the provisions of
8 Chapter 151 of the General Laws, said person shall remain
9 insured under such policy for the period of time said person is
10 deemed eligible for benefits under Chapter 151.
