AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO PAY CERTAIN INDEBTEDNESS FROM CERTAIN FEDERAL AND STATE REIMBURSEMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section eleven of Chapter one hundred thirty-two A of the  
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by Chapter one hundred  
3 seventy-nine of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by  
4 striking the fourth sentence thereof and inserting the following  
5 sentence: — Any reimbursement received by a city or town under  
6 this section shall be applied, without further appropriation, to the  
7 payment of indebtedness, if any, incurred in acquiring land for  
8 such conservation project.
