The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT INSURANCE AGENTS AND BROKERS MAY ORGANIZE PROFESSIONAL CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 156A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph (b), as most recently amended
3 by chapter 478 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following paragraph: —

5 (b) "Professional service", the personal service performed by
6 registered physicians and surgeons, chiropractors, podiatrists,
7 engineers, electrologists, physical therapists, psychologists,
8 certified public accountants, public accountants, dentists,
9 insurance agents and brokers, veterinarians and optometrists, all
10 of whom are registered under chapter one hundred and twelve,
11 and by attorneys-at-law admitted to practice in the courts of the
12 commonwealth under chapter two hundred and twenty-one.
