In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN PERSONS IN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (1) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 94 of the acts of 1971, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence of
4 paragraph (c) and inserting in place thereof the following
5 sentence: — A member in service or a member inactive as defined
6 in clauses (i) and (ii), respectively, or beneficiary having any
7 rights or privileges under the provisions of Sections 1 to 28,
8 inclusive, shall retain only such rights or privileges as provided in
9 said sections and which are applicable to his membership status.
