AN ACT TO BAN THE OPERATION OF AND COOPERATION WITH THE PRIVATE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION KNOWN AS INTERPOL, THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL POLICE ORGANIZATION, WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No individual, group, agency, law enforcement organization,
- 2 or police force, within the commonwealth of Massachusetts, may
- 3 give or receive any data on any citizen of the United States, any
- 4 alien, or any group or organization based in the United States or
- 5 abroad to or from INTERPOL.
