AN ACT TO AMEND THE OPEN MEETING REMEDY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23C of chapter 39 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by chapter 83 of the acts of 1974 is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof
4 the following sentence: — Such order shall invalidate any action
5 taken at any meeting which violates the provisions of this
6 chapter, chapter 30A, 34 or 36, providing that, such petition is
7 filed within thirty days of the date when such action is taken.
