AN ACT TO DEFINE EXPRESS SERVICE, AND TO CHANGE THE ASSESSMENT FORMULA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 161A as most recently
2 amended by chapter 1140 of the acts of 1973 is further amended
3 by adding at the end thereof the following: — If, however, a city
4 or town has a terminal station, as defined below, the twenty-five
5 per cent of such net cost of service assessed on such city or town
6 shall be in the proportion which the number of residents of such
7 city or town boarding at the terminal station and the number of
8 riders boarding at any other express service stations in such city
9 or town bears to the number of riders boarding at all express
10 service stations in the area constituting the authority; and
11 provided further, that the amount not assessed upon such city or
12 town as a result of the location of a terminal station therein, shall
13 be assessed on the cities or towns in the area constituting the
14 authority in proportion which the respective number of residents
15 of each such city or town boarding at such terminal station bears
16 to the total number of riders boarding at all express service
17 stations in the area constituting the authority.

1 SECTION 2. Section ten of chapter one hundred and sixty-
2 one A of the General Laws is hereby repealed.
