RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE
FEASIBILITY OF USING THE METRIC SYSTEM OF MEASUREMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the Senate, three members of the House of
3 Representatives, and one person to be appointed by the
4 Governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
5 investigation and study of the feasibility of implementing the
6 metric system of measurement within the Commonwealth and
7 making recommendations thereof.
