## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE REDRAWING OF THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION LINES OF THE DISTRICT COURTS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represent-  
3 atives, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, one of  
4 whom shall be the chief justice of the supreme judicial court or his  
5 designee, one of whom shall be the chief justice of the district  
6 courts or his designee, and one of whom shall be the president of  
7 the Massachusetts Bar Association, is hereby established for the  
8 purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the  
9 possibility of reconstituting the judicial districts comprising the  
10 territorial jurisdiction of the several district courts.
