The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRAINING OF RAILROAD POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Every such person appointed pursuant to this Section shall,
2 within 18 months of the date of his appointment, attend and
3 satisfactorily complete a police training school approved by the
4 municipal police training council pursuant to Chapter 41 of
5 Section 96B. The expenses of attendance at such school shall be
6 at the sole cost and expense of the railroad corporation,
7 company, Terminal Corporation, or common carrier employer of
8 the officer. If any person appointed pursuant to this Section does
9 not attend and satisfactorily complete the police training course
10 required herein, the department, on notice from the employer
11 involved, shall revoke his appointment as an officer.
