AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause (i) of section 5 of chapter 354 of the Acts
2 of 1952 is hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty" and
3 inserting in place thereof the words: — five hundred.

1 SECTION 2. Clause (d) of section 5 of chapter 598 of the Acts
2 of 1958 is hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty" and
3 inserting in place thereof the words: — five hundred.
