### AN ACT TO FACILITATE ABSENTEE VOTING IN PERSON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 54 of the General Laws is amended by inserting after
- 2 Section 64 the following new section:—
- 3 64A. In every city and town, the main office of the Board of
- 4 Registrars or the Election Commissioners shall be open on the
- 5 Saturday preceding any election for a minimum of two hours and
- 6 a maximum of four hours between 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. for
- 7 the purpose of permitting absentee voting in person.
