AN ACT TO PROVIDE A CERTIFIED EXECUTIVE HOUSEKEEPER FOR CERTAIN HOSPITAL, HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE BUILDINGS, MOTELS AND HOTELS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That any duly accredited hospital, by the Joint Commission  
2 Accreditation Hospitals, of 100 beds or over, any health care  
3 facility licensed by the Department of Public Health 100 beds or  
4 over, any hotel or motel 100 beds or over, any accredited college  
5 or university 100 beds or over on a minimum of 250,000 square  
6 feet of internal building space, any public, private building  
7 renting office space with a minimum of 250,000 square feet shall  
8 have in their employ a full time certified executive housekeeper,  
9 who is qualified under the standards and is acceptable to and by  
10 the National Executive Housekeepers Incorporated, for the  
11 educational requirements set forth for such certification.
