AN ACT RELATIVE TO REQUIRING CITY/TOWN CLERKS TO NOTIFY CITY/TOWN AGENCIES, BOARDS, DEPARTMENTS, COMMISSIONS OF LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 48 of Chapter 40 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 350 of the Acts of 1919 is hereby further
3 amended by adding after the last sentence the following sentence:
4 — Any law received from the Commonwealth by the town clerk
5 and that affects any city or town department, board, commission
6 or agency the Clerk shall notify such department, board,
7 commission or agency of such law.
