AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ELDERLY REAL ESTATE EXEMPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws
2 as appearing in section one of chapter 456 of the acts of 1970 is
3 hereby amended by striking out in lines seventeen and eighteen
4 and in line thirty-eight the words: — seven thousand dollars and
5 inserting in place thereof in both instances the words: — ten
6 thousand dollars.
