## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT GEOGRAPHIC DATA ON MORTGAGES AND HOME IMPROVEMENT LOANS BE MAINTAINED BY CERTAIN BANKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 9 of chapter 167 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following sentence: — The said annual  
3 reports for trust companies, savings banks, cooperative banks  
4 and credit unions shall include a quarterly statement of the  
5 geographic distribution by town or ward within a city, of the  
6 deposits and investments of each such financial institution, listing  
7 the total dollar amount and the number of time deposits,  
8 mortgages, Veterans' Administration and FHA mortgages and  
9 home improvement loans.
