By Mr. Melia of Boston, petition of Kevin H. White and John F. Melia that fuel consumed by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority be exempt from the fuel tax. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT TO EXEMPT FUEL CONSUMED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FROM FUEL TAXES PAID TO THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any and all Massachusetts fuel taxes paid by the
- 2 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall be reimbursed
- 3 to the Authority from the highway fund. Within sixty days of
- 4 receipt from the Authority of documentation of Massachusetts
- 5 fuel taxes paid during the prior month, the treasurer shall return
- 6 to the Authority from the highway fund the amount certified by
- 7 him to have been paid into the highway fund in fuel taxes.
