

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 5, 6, 7.

Chap. 5. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXEMPTION OF A CERTAIN POSITION IN THE TOWN OF ANDOVER FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CIVIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 350 of the acts of 1981 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the word "electrical" and inserting in place thereof the following word:- gas.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of August sixteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

Chap. 6. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF CITY ELECTRICIAN IN THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the position of city electrician in the city of Gloucester shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 7. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE FOOTBRIDGE OVER THE JAMES J. STORROW MEMORIAL DRIVE AT BLOSSOM STREET IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE MONSIGNOR CHARLES A. FINN BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The footbridge over the James J. Storrow Memorial drive at Blossom street in the city of Boston shall be designated and known as the Monsignor Charles A. Finn bridge in memory of Monsignor Charles A. Finn who has been prominent in civic and charitable projects. A suitable marker bearing such designation shall be attached thereto by the metropolitan district commission.
