## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LOCAL TAXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 17 of chapter 465 of  
2 the acts of 1956 is hereby amended by striking out all after the  
3 word "commonwealth", in line fourteen, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following words: — ; provided, however, that  
5 anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding, lands of the  
6 Authority, if used or occupied for other than public purposes, or  
7 if business is being conducted thereon for private profit shall be  
8 taxed under section three A of chapter fifty-nine of the General  
9 Laws as if such land were real estate owned by the com-  
10 monwealth.

1 SECTION 2. Section three A of chapter fifty-nine of the  
2 General Laws, as amended by section one of chapter six hundred  
3 and sixty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-one, is  
4 hereby further amended by striking out the last sentence.

**The Commission on Education**

1. All members of the House shall be eligible to serve on the Commission on Education.

2. The Commission shall be composed of seven members, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House.

**SECTION 1.** The first session of the Commission shall be held on the first day of January, 1950, at the city of Washington, D. C.
