AN ACT REQUIRING POLICE PATROLS IN CERTAIN PUBLIC HOUSING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 121B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 26A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 26B.* Every housing authority operating a housing
- 4 project containing at least two hundred dwelling units shall
- 5 maintain a uniformed police force to patrol such project and its
- 6 grounds.
