AN ACT RESTRICTING THE FLIGHT OF AIRCRAFT OVER ATHLETIC STADIUMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 46 the following section: —

3 *Section 46A.* No aircraft displaying advertising signs and
4 information shall be operated within that portion of the navigable
5 air space directly above or in the immediate vicinity of any
6 athletic field or stadium at which an athletic event is being
7 attended by members of the public.
