AN ACT ABOLISHING THE DIVISION OF IMMIGRATION AND AMERICANIZATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1D of Chapter 15 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking the twentieth paragraph thereof,
3 which reads as follows: —

4 “The board shall take cognizance of the problems of
5 immigration and Americanization within the Commonwealth
6 and provide a program adequate to meet the needs of such
7 problems.”

1 SECTION 2. Section 11 of Chapter 69 of the General Laws is
2 hereby repealed.
